5. **NOTICES OF MOTION:-**

The following Notices of Motion were given:-

THAT, AWARE that Kenya is in the piloting stage of a new education system, the 2-6-6-3 system which places stronger emphasis on Early Childhood Development and Education, specifically including two years for ECDE in place of the one year included in the 8-4-4 system;

COGNIZANT OF THE FACT THAT there are 895 public primary schools in Makueni County, each with an ECDE centre; there are 409 independent feeder ECDE centres; and there are 253 private ECDE centres;

FURTHER AWARE that, with the exception of the private ECDE centres, the county government is responsible for equipping and staffing 1,304 ECDE centres;

NOTING WITH CONCERN that the County Government has only employed 896 teachers, hence leaving 408 centres without teachers and that most of those ECDE Centers without a County Government teacher rely on teachers procured by the schools, some of whom are not qualified ECDE teachers;

CONCERNED that the new curriculum shall require two teachers per ECDE centre, which will under the current circumstances necessitate employment of 1,712 teachers immediately;

NOW THEREFORE, this County Assembly urges the County Government of Makueni to staff each ECDE centre with at least two teachers forthem to deliver on their mandates effectively and also to motivate the teachers.
