The contractor had installed 37 starter bars in within the County in which 25 were working for which he was paid Kshs 6,289,875.50.

The contract was terminated and the works retendered and awarded to six contractors as tabulated below;

On page 8 by deleting all the recommendations and replacing therefor the following;

1. The department should fast-track all the projects in the county and ensure that all were completely installed as per the specifications provided in the BQs and working,
2. The Department should ensure that the faulty floodlights were repaired and the vandalized lights replaced within 30 days from the date of adoption of this report.
3. The Department should raise the masts or align the solar lamps in order to illuminate a wider area.
4. The Department should engage its technical officers to carry out a verification exercise of all installed solar lights to ascertain that all specifications in the BQs were met and where not adhered to the contractor must be recalled to redo the work.
5. The PMCs should not approve for the payment of the contractor until the Department validates that the installation was as per the BQs because most of the BQs provided to the PMCs were illegible.
6. The ECM should halt all the payments until the works are certified by a technical officers and a report on the status of all flood lights forwarded to this house certifying that all flood lights in the County were in good condition and working.
