- i. **THAT**, this County Assembly adopts the Report of the Makueni County Assembly Members on the Educational Tour to the United Arab Emirates (Dubai) conducted from 14th to 19th April, 2014,

- ii. **THAT**, aware that Section 116 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012, empowers the County Executive Committee Member for Finance to establish other public funds with the approval of the County Executive Committee and the County Assembly; further aware that, on 10th March, 2015, the County Assembly approved the Public Finance Management (Makueni County Bursary Fund) Regulations, 2014, submitted by the County Executive Committee Member for Finance and Planning aimed at providing for a bursary scheme for the provision of financial assistance to needy students; noting that regulation 9 has provided for the establishment of a County Bursary Committee, with regulation 11 providing for the establishment of a Ward Bursary Committee for each Ward; concerned that as currently constituted there is no student representative in the bursary committees at both the County and Ward levels; deeply concerned that the students as the core beneficiaries of the bursary fund should have a representative through whom they can present their views, this County Assembly urges the County Government of Makueni to review the Public Finance Management (Makueni County Bursary Fund) Regulations, 2014 to include a representative of the students in the County and Ward Bursary Committees, to enhance the representation of the students.
