9*. MOTION: FORMULATION OF A POLICY FRAMEWORK FOR INVOLVING THE YOUTH IN PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AND DECISION MAKING PROGRAMMES IN THE COUNTY, IDENTIFYING, NURTURING AND ADDRESSING ISSUES AFFECTING THE YOUTH

THAT, AWARE that Article 55 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 provides that *“The State shall take measures, including affirmative action programmes, to ensure that the youth—*

(a) access relevant education and training;

(b) have opportunities to associate, be represented and participate in political, social, economic and other spheres of life;

(c) access employment; and

(d) are protected from harmful cultural practices and exploitation”

APPRECIATING that the Department of Education, Youth, Sports and ICT embraces sports and other socio-economic activities in Makueni County;

FURTHER APPRECIATING that the Department can create youth led initiatives which can subsequently spearhead transformative mindset change amongst the youth in the County through capacity development, innovation and entrepreneurship;

CONCERNED that the County Government may sometimes execute projects which may not directly and effectively transform the livelihoods of the youth, making them relatively disadvantaged in socio-economic outcomes such as employment, hence majority of them remain on the periphery of the County's social, economic and political affairs;

NOTING that the highest rates of labour underutilization are always observed among the youth and many continue to suffer from low education attainment, skills deficits, poor health and lack sufficient economic empowerment among out of school youth;

FURTHER NOTING that youth with specific needs require enhanced attention since they have diverse talents, passion and innovation ideas which can be tapped through capacity enabling and financial support from the County Government;

COGNIZANCE to the critical role that voluntary youth sector and other relevant stakeholders can play in actively supporting implementation of the youth agenda for the County's inclusive socio-economic transformation;

NOW THEREFORE this County Assembly urges the County Department of Education, Youth, Sports and ICT to formulate a policy framework for involving the youth in public participation/decision making programmes in the County, identifying, nurturing and addressing issues affecting the youth, notably employment creation, health, education, sports and recreation, environment, art and culture, partnership, empowerment and other emerging social, cultural, economic and political issues in order to support them to improve their livelihoods through their talents and passion.
