8*. MOTION: - FORMULATION OF SUITABLE MONITORING AND EVALUATION TOOLS FOR USE DURING PROJECT VERIFICATION EXERCISES IN THE COUNTY

THAT, **APPRECIATING** that Article 185(3) of the Constitution, 2010, provides that, a County Assembly, while respecting the principle of the separation of powers, may exercise oversight over the County Executive Committee and any other County Executive organs, **FURTHER APPRECIATING** that Section 9(1) (a), (b) and (d) of the County Governments Act, 2012, stipulates that a Member of a County Assembly shall maintain close contact with the electorate and consult them on issues before or under discussion in the county assembly; present views, opinions and proposals of the electorate to the County Assembly and provide a linkage

between the County Assembly and the electorate on public service delivery; CONCERNED that the County Assembly of Makueni has in the past conducted project verification exercises without clearly defined monitoring and evaluation mechanisms; **AWARE** that the said project verification exercises have been conducted based on the Members' professional knowledge, experience or technical expertise; **COGNIZANT** that the exercise would be more effective if clear monitoring and evaluation guidelines were put in place; **NOW THEREFORE** this County Assembly resolves to allocate funds for the County Assembly Service Board to facilitate the formulation of suitable monitoring and evaluation tools for use by Members of the County Assembly of Makueni during the project verification exercises across the County, so as to demonstrate effectiveness in assessing extent to which set objectives have been met and impact of projects on people's lives; improve decision making on project proposals by the public during public participation exercises and subsequent implementation in terms of success factors, barriers and approaches; ensure accountability of key stakeholders such as the Community, the County Government and donors; influence government policy, with an objective of obtaining value for money during project implementation.
