NOTICE OF AMENDMENTS

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE ASSEMBLY CONSIDERING THE MAKUENI COUNTY OFFICE OF THE COUNTY ATTORNEY BILL, 2017(MAKUENI COUNTY ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 10 OF 2017)

NOTICE is hereby given that the Chairperson, Committee on Devolution and Public Service intends to move the following amendments to the Makueni County Office of the County Attorney Bill, 2017(Makueni County Assembly Bill No. 10 of 2017) during Committee stage: -

CLAUSE 5

THAT, Clause 5 be amended by deleting the whole clause and replacing therefor with-

“The County Attorney shall be appointed from among persons who;

- a) Is a citizen of Kenya;
- b) Holds a degree from a university recognized in Kenya;
- c) Is an advocate of the High Court of Kenya;
- d) Has at least five years relevant professional experience; and
- e) Meets the requirements of leadership and integrity set out in Chapter six of the Constitution.”

CLAUSE 18

THAT, Clause 18 be amended by deleting the whole clause and replacing therefor with -

“1. There is established the office of County Solicitor who shall be appointed by the Governor with the approval of the County Assembly.

2. The Governor shall nominate a person from among three persons recommended by the County Public Service Board.

3. A person shall be qualified for appointment to the office of County Solicitor if the person –

- a) Is a Kenyan citizen;
- b) Holds a degree from a university recognized in Kenya;
- c) Is an advocate of the High Court of Kenya with at least five years' experience
- d) Meets the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution of Kenya;

4. The office of County Solicitor shall be an office in the county public service.

5. The County Solicitor shall be an authorized officer in respect of the exercise of delegated power.

6. The County Solicitor shall assist the County Attorney in the performance of the duties of the County Attorney.

7. the County Solicitor shall be responsible for –

- a) Organizing and coordinating administrative and legal functions of the County Attorney's office;
- b) Assisting the County Attorney in performance of his duties as principal legal advisor to the County Government; and
- c) Performing such other duties as may be conferred by law or otherwise assigned by the County Attorney.

8. The Governor may reassign a County Solicitor.

9. A County Solicitor may resign from office by giving notice to the Governor.

CLAUSE 3

THAT, the term “Deputy County Attorney” as appearing in Clause 3 and subsequent clauses be replaced with the term “County Solicitor”.
