- 8*. **MOTION:-ESTABLISHMENT OF A RAPID RESPONSE COMMITTEE TO ADDRESS THE EFFECTS OF THE FLOODS IN THE COUNTY.**

(Leader of the Majority Party)

THAT, NOTING that the Constitution of Kenya 2010 allows for cooperation between the National and County Governments under Article 189 which stipulates that:-

- 1) Government at either level shall—
 - a) perform its functions, and exercise its powers, in a manner that respects the functional and institutional integrity of government at the level, and respects the constitutional status and institutions of government at the other level and, in the case of county government, within the county level;

- b) assist, support and consult and, as appropriate, implement the legislation of the other level of government; and
 - c) liaise with government at the other level for the purpose of exchanging information, coordinating policies and administration and enhancing capacity.
- 2) Government at each level, and different governments at the county level, shall co-operate in the performance of functions and exercise of powers and, for that purpose, may set up joint committees and joint authorities.

AWARE THAT the on-going heavy rains have resulted to flooding in the County which has resulted to Loss of lives, Loss of property through erosion and mudslides, Destruction of infrastructure such as roads, dams and houses rendering various households homeless, destroying infrastructure and thus interrupting service delivery to the citizens by both the national and county governments;

FURTHER AWARE THAT the loss of lives, property and destruction of infrastructure arising from the ongoing floods require concerted efforts and cooperation between the national government, county government and non-state actors to identify the disasters, profile them, mobilize resources and develop strategies to address the disaster caused by the long rains;

NOW THEREFORE, this Assembly urges H.E. the Governor, County Government of Makueni and the County Commissioner, Makueni County to jointly establish a Rapid Response Committee consisting of representatives of the National and County Governments and non-state actors to be charged with coordinating efforts geared towards addressing the effects of the floods in the County and identifying the necessary emergency response measures.
