**8\*. MOTION: - URGING THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF MAKUENI TO DONATE THE UNSERVICEABLE AND OBSOLETE VEHICLES TO THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRES**

**THAT, AWARE THAT,** the Technical Vocational Education and Training Act 2013, provides for the establishment of a technical and vocational education and training system mandated to provide for the governance and management of institutions offering technical and vocational education, training services, and provide for coordinated assessment, examination and certification; to institute a mechanism for promoting access and equity in training.

**NOTING THAT**, Vocational Training Centres (VTCs) have been identified as efficient training grounds at the County level to impart skills in both the formal and informal sectors;

**AWARE THAT**, Motor Vehicle Mechanics course requires vehicles as an important teaching tool for the training cycle to be completed, yet most training centres lack sufficient and properly equipped learning workshops, necessitating moving to other centres for practical lessons and exams;

**NOTING** the urgent need to specifically address the lack of training equipment in the Motor Vehicle Mechanics related courses;

**WHEREAS** the County Government of Makueni has unserviceable and obsolete vehicles at its disposal; and **NOTING** that the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015 Section 165 (1) (a) allows for transfer of assets from one public entity to another public entity or part of a public entity with or without financial adjustment;

**NOW THEREFORE**, this County Assembly urges the County Government of Makueni to donate the unserviceable and obsolete vehicles to the Vocational Training Centres, to address the lack of training tools in the Motor Vehicle Mechanics related courses, even as Government puts measures in place to have the Training Centres well equipped and facilitated to offer the requisite training.
