**8\* MOTION:- FORMULATION OF A MAKUENI COUNTY PUBLIC  
PROCUREMENT AND ASSET DISPOSAL POLICY**

**THAT, AWARE THAT** the fourth schedule of the Constitution devolves County public works and services,

**FURTHER AWARE THAT** the Constitution under Article 227(2) provides for procurement of public goods and services pursuant to which the Public Procurement and Assets Disposal Act No. 33 of 2015 was enacted to give effect to the said provision and to provide procedures for effective public procurement and assets disposal by public entities.

**AWARE THAT** every public procurement must fall within the framework of the Act and must be in accordance with a system that is fair, equitable, transparent, competitive and cost effective.

**FURTHER AWARE THAT** Section 33 of the Act provides for roles and responsibilities of the County Government in respect to public procurement and assets disposal and in particular that the County treasury shall be the organ responsible for the implementation of the public procurement and asset disposal policy in the County and shall establish a procurement function to among others:-

- a. Implement public procurement and asset disposal procedures;
- b. Coordinate administration of procurement and asset disposal contracts;
- c. Promote preference and reservation schemes for residents in the County to ensure a minimum of 20% in public procurement in the County, as well as;
- d. Promote preference and reservation schemes for small and micro enterprises and other disadvantaged groups, citizen contractors, women, youth, persons with disabilities, minorities and marginalized groups in public procurement at the county with section 157 providing for application of the preferences and reservations.

**COGNIZANT OF THE FACT THAT** the County Government has established a procurement function with no existing policy in conformity with Sections 33 and 157 of the Act.

**NOW THEREFORE,** this Assembly urges the County Treasury to formulate a Makueni County Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Policy which should conform to Sections 33 and 157 of the Act and;

- a. In cognizance of the right of access to information enshrined under Article 35 of the Constitution and Section 87 (a) of the County Government Act, ensure availability at the elected Members' ward office, a copy of the Bill of Quantities for every project being implemented at the Ward level.

- b. In recognition of the right to citizen participation as stipulated under Section 87 of the County Government Act, require that every Bill of Quantities developed for a project provides for manual labour where applicable and; ensure that the labour is sourced from the locality of the project.
